
The third stage was the same as the final one, the only differing in the color scheme. I eventually changed it to white and blue, and thus, Mark was born!

THE "ROCKET GRAPPLE" ABILITY






The beam connectors are, simply put, magnets. The beam itself serves the purpose of channeling that magnetic force, allowing the hand to come back.




X-ray of Mark's forearm. Note the line separating the hand portion from the rest of the arm.



When not in use, the hand stays connected to the forearm with a simple lock device on the thrusters.
